





# **Conducting a Voter Registration Drive in Idaho**

# **Voter Registration Deadlines**

- Received by election officials or postmarked by 25 days before Election Day.
- Idaho allows Election Day registration.

## **Getting Started**

**Training Requirement:** Idaho does not require training for registration drives.

**Notification and Registration Requirements:** Idaho does not have notification requirements for registration drives.

**Compensation Restrictions:** Do not pay registration drive participants based on how many registrations they collect.

### **Handling Applications**

**Incomplete Applications:** Do not fill in any missing information on a registration form unless you have permission from the applicant.

**Photocopying Completed Applications:** As a best practice, a voter's full or partial Social Security number and/or driver's license number should not be retained.

#### **Obtaining Applications**

**State Form:** The state mail-in voter registration application can be obtained at the <u>county clerk's office</u> or downloaded from the <u>Secretary of State's Idaho Votes website</u>.

**Federal Form:** The <u>federal mail-in voter registration</u> <u>application</u> may be used in Idaho registration drives.

**Photocopying Blank Forms:** Blank applications may be photocopied and used in voter registration drives.
