

Conducting a Voter Registration Drive in Montana

Voter Registration Deadlines

Applications must be received or postmarked 30 days before any election <u>and</u> received within three days thereafter.

"Late registration" is also available and may be completed by an individual in-person at county elections offices through noon the day before Election Day.

Federal Form: The <u>federal mail-in voter registration</u> <u>application</u> may be used in voter registration drives.

Photocopying Blank Forms: Blank applications may be photocopied and used in voter registration drives.
