Resolution Recognizing September 15, 2026 as National Voter Registration Day

WHEREAS, the [State / County / Municipal Elections Office] is committed to promoting broad voter registration, access to accurate election information, and meaningful participation in elections among eligible citizens; and

WHEREAS, National Voter Registration Day is a nationwide, nonpartisan civic holiday dedicated to ensuring that eligible Americans have the opportunity to register to vote, update their voter registration information, and access trusted information about the registration process; and

WHEREAS, many eligible voters may be unable to participate in elections because they miss a voter registration deadline, have not updated their registration after moving or changing their name, or are unfamiliar with the voter registration process; and

WHEREAS, election officials serve as trusted sources of accurate, timely, and nonpartisan information about voter registration requirements, deadlines, eligibility, and election administration; and

WHEREAS, collaboration among election officials, nonprofit organizations, libraries, colleges and universities, housing providers, businesses, community organizations, and other local partners can help expand access to reliable voter registration information and reach eligible voters where they live, work, study, and gather; and

WHEREAS, National Voter Registration Day provides an opportunity for election offices and community partners across the country to work together in a coordinated, nonpartisan effort to promote voter registration and civic participation; and

WHEREAS, providing voters with reliable and trusted public information strengthens confidence in the electoral process and helps ensure that eligible citizens are prepared to participate in upcoming elections;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the **[State / County / Municipal Elections Office]** hereby recognizes **Tuesday, September 15, 2026, as National Voter Registration Day**; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the **[State / County / Municipal Elections Office]** encourages eligible residents to verify their voter registration status, register to vote or update their registration as needed, and seek election information from trusted state and local election officials; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the **[State / County / Municipal Elections Office]** joins election officials, civic organizations, nonprofits, educational institutions, community partners, and other organizations nationwide in recognizing National Voter Registration Day and supporting nonpartisan voter registration and public education efforts.
